## **January Meeting**

Reports on Trips to Ukraine and Poland by Mike Dowhan and Frank Cedar

Mike Dowhan and Frank Cedar gave very informative reports on their recent trips to Ukraine and Poland. Mike emphasized the benefits of travel planning before leaving home. He suggested that travelers to Ukraine should check various alternative options regarding hotels, air travel, trains and also the use of rental cars. The problem with rental cars in Ukraine is the state of the roads while renting cars in Poland is not a problem. Travel later in the Fall may be more economical but the days are shorter which limits sightseeing. Mike suggested that information regarding travel to Ukraine may be obtained from travel agencies that specialize in trips to Ukraine such as Bloor Travel in Toronto.

Frank Cedar is an experienced traveler and researcher who has made several research trips to Ukraine and Poland. On this trip, he traveled in January and spent three weeks in Poland and Ukraine. He visited with relatives and celebrated the traditional Ukrainian Christmas. He had the opportunity to examine and identify family photos. His trip to Poland was particularly successful and he visited various archives and examined documents which were formerly restricted. He also visited villages in Poland and renewed acquaintances with parish priests and officials. During his presentation, Frank showed copies of documents with information relevant to his family history.

Both presentations were well prepared and instructive. The presentations were followed by a questions period.
